Programs Committee Goals

“The Programs Committee shall coordinate the planning, execution, and administration of events and activities of WAAAUB, shall work with chapters to encourage chapter events and activities, and shall encourage cooperative activities among the chapters and participation in WAAAUB events.”

Goals are dedicated to expand alumni programs on the:

1. local level at AUB
2. the worldwide level by developing programs furthering WAAAUB's missions and goals
3. the chapter level by ensuring chapter program activity meets WAAAUB objectives and mission and expands beyond current levels.

Program Committee Objectives (2008-09)

The following proposed objectives aims at serving the three Goals stated above.

1. Local level at AUB
 - a. Develop an annual event/ activity for young AUB Alumni (Graduating by the end of each academic year).
 - i. Graduating Travel Trip (First Week of July: Greece, turkey, or Cyprus)
 - b. In coordination with Alumni Relations office, plan and assist with the implementation of the Class Reunion.
(JULY 2008)
 - c. Develop a *proposal for an alumni benefit package to bring to WAAAUB leadership and AUB administration.* (This proposal should cover benefits provided by AUB to alumni and benefits from outside AUB).
(Ongoing- Reviewed Quarterly)
(In Collaboration with the Chapters Committee)
 - i. Airline Special Fares and Reward Program for AUB ALUMNI
 - ii. Hotel Chains Special Fares and Rewards Programs

- iii. In Collaboration with the Scholarship Fund Raising Committee – Develop the AUB – (Bank X) Credit Card Program in a way to Special Rates and benefits with a benefit to the university for every dollar paid.
 - iv. Restaurants, Malls, etc Group Rates to AUB ALumni
- 2. Worldwide level
 - a. Support in the planning and execution of the Annual Alumni Awards Program (see chapters policies and procedures).
(July 2008 Reunion)
 - b. Work with WAAAUB Board and Alumni Relations for programmatic content of the annual Council Meeting and Biennial WAAAUB Convention.
(January 2009)
- 3. Chapters Level
 - a. Phonathons- student employees contact undergraduate and graduate alumni for annual support. This is one of the most enjoyable jobs on campus that gives students an opportunity to strengthen their communication and overall improve their resume while receiving a high level of compensation. - Build on AUB experience in this field and experiment expanding it to chapters.
 - b. Recommend to chapters to promote.
 - i. Dinner Events
 - ii. Joint Events
 - iii. young alumni activities
 - iv. Cultural Events
 - c. Plan and Implement one regional event/ activity in coordination with the relevant Chapters.
(Summer 2008, Europe)
 - d. In coordination with Chapters and Outreach Committee, develop "WAAAUB Alumni Programs Guide" a compendium of 'best practice' programs undertaken by various alumni chapters worldwide.
 - e. In coordination with the chapters committee, contact all chapters in order to publish a WAAAUB Programs Plan for the Year
